### Parking:

**Establishing a separate event parking in downtown is not possible.** Please choose one of the parking areas on the below map and the annex. You can see the street names where you can park if you zoom in on the <u>interactive map</u>. Some streets are forbidden area due to the competition that's why being and parking there is unfair during the competition.

Parking is free of charge after 18:00 on weekdays, and whole Saturdays and Sundays. On weekdays between 8:00 and 18:00 you must pay for it. You can buy parking ticket in the traffics or you can pay via mobile phones. Clubs with big buses can park at the quay of Huszár Mátyás at the bus park area near the finish (signed by yellow star on the map).

# **Public transport:**

Destination bus/tram/trolley stop (signed on the map) called Széchenyi sqaure. 200 m from Móra Ferenc Mueseum (Even Centre).

Planned "0" time: 9:00

### Quarantine:

Until 9:00 competitors must be inside in the quarantine area! Who misses the quarantine closing time will be disqualified.

Location: Following the white and blue stripes from the Event Centre. Length 800 m. Drinking water will be served and in case of bad weather indoor area will be provided.

### **Starting:**

The SI clearing and checking is done by individually in front of the start area. Competitors will step in to the start are 3 minutes before the start. Competitors can see their maps at the start moment. An information plate will notify the competitors about the order of the maps. It is important to check the

map and the category by individually as well. ID number of control point will not be printed on the map near the control circle, but the sequence number.

# Symbol:

Extra symbols are available before the start, competitors can use them individually. Organizers will provide scissors and stick tapes.

### **Start number:**

There will be no race number used during the qualification.

### **Special restrictions:**

Courses cross some roads without heavy traffic, but please keep the rules of the KRESZ (rules of traffic). There are many loops, acutangular turns and control point are in density, so there is a risk for missing a point or missing the sequence of the points.

It is not allowed to access, cross, jump through or down some marked area on the map like high walls, high fences, olive green areas (flower beds), purple marked places.

Please be fair during the competition.

#### **Terrain:**

Mainly urban housing estates and parks with many objects and some floodplain forest. Using of spike orienteering shoe is forbidden!

#### Map:

Created in 2015, scale 1:4000 (ISSOM), contours 1m. Size: 401 x 214mm in category M18, M20, M21-1, M21-2, M21-3, M35-1, M35-2, the other has A/4 (210 x 297mm). Waterproof map material (pretex), extra foil is not need.

### Finish, SI read-out:

Those competitors who do not have the SI result read out at the finish of the Qualification until 11 o'clock will be disqualified.

The Final and the Qualification finish area are not in the same place. Blue and white stripes lead to the Event Centre (500 m)

### Map collection:

Maps do not need to be handed over.

# **Result processing, Final start list:**

Results and Final start list can be followed at the Event Centre on the result table (paper), big screen TVs or online.

Planned start list of the Finals from 12:00.

### **Qualification system:**

24 competitors qualify to the Final "A", the next 24 qualify to the Final "B", etc... Competitors with foreigner citizenships are also counted to the Final number of participants. If there is a Final (B,C,D) where the number of participants is less 5 then those competitors will classify to a higher Final class.

Location: Following the white and blue stripes from the Event Centre. Length 200 m. Drinking water will be served and in case of bad weather indoor area will be provided. There are not too many places for heating that's why please keep the organizers instructions.

### **Starting:**

The SI clearing and checking is done by individually in front of the start area. Competitors will step in to the start are 3 minutes before the start. Competitors can see their maps at the start moment. An information plate will notify the competitors about the order of the maps. It is important to check the map and the category by individually as well. ID number of control point will not be printed on the map near the control circle, but the sequence number.

### **Symbol:**

Extra symbols are available before the start, competitors can use them individually. Organizers will provide scissors and stick tapes.

#### **Start number:**

Competitors qualified to Final "A" must wear their start numbers. It can be pick up inside the quarantine from 13:30. Start number like F21-1 shows the category and the inverse of the start sequence, in this example the last starter competitor.

### **Special restrictions:**

Courses cross the tram lines. Trams will operate with a slower speed then the usual. Some walking roads have ropes besides about 20-25 cm high, organizers tries to make them visible by hanging colorful straps on these ropes.

It is not allowed to access, cross, jump through or down some marked area on the map like high walls, high fences, olive green areas (flower beds), purple marked places.

Please be fair during the competition.

#### Terrain:

Downtown of Szeged with parks, detailed atriums, busy areas with tourists. Using of spike orienteering shoes are forbidden and unreasonable!

### Map:

Created in 2015, 1:4000 scale (ISSOM), contour 1 m. Size A/4 (210 x 297mm). Waterproof map material (pretex), extra foil is not need.

# RELAY – 2015. SEPTEMBER 13. SUNDAY

#### **General information:**

- Categories V14, V18 and V21 have 4 legs, 2 men and 2 women, the sequence of them is determined: women men women, women can run on a men lag, but men cannot run on women leg
- Categories V105, V135, V165 and V195 have 3 legs, at least one women and maximum 2 men, the sequence of the participant is free. There are 3 different legs: long middle short in this order.

Planned relay winning time is 60 minutes in each category.

### **Relay member registration:**

On Saturday (12th September) 12:00 - 17:30.

Planned "0" time: 9:30 Demo relaying: 9:15

#### First runners start:

V195: 9:40

### **Relaying:**

In the finish area there will be 2 spectator points which every runner will check. These point will be connected with a cordon. Team are responsible for watching their members on the spectator points at the Museum's ramp or under the bridge. After the spectator point there is 3-8 minutes to the finish depends on the category. If a runner passes the spectator point then the next runner is allowed to enter to the relay zone and pick up the rolled up map. Map can be seen only after the relaying (touch). Finishing runner will punch the finish SI after the shift.

Close run in: the first who pass the finish line wins.

### Special restrictions and risks:

Courses cross some roads without heavy traffic, but please keep the rules of the KRESZ (rules of traffic). There are many loops, acutangular turns and control point are in density, so there is a risk for missing a point or missing the sequence of the points.

It is not allowed to access, cross, jump through or down some marked area on the map like high walls, high fences, olive green areas (flower beds), purple marked places.

Please be fair during the competition.

Maps must be handed over after finish. Maps can be collected after 13:30, after the last competitors start. Any not picked up maps will be posted by mail.

## **Control points, punching:**

At the controls there is a orange white buoy and a SPORTident box (more will be placed out if the point is busy) and an old style puncher.

The old style puncher must be used if SPORTident does not work. When it happens, punch must be done to the side of the map.

### Online result broadcast:

Online result broadcast is available in the Event Centre area. Wi-Fi capable devices have to connect to the SSID 'eredmeny' then the browser has to open eredmeny.html. If there is any question, organizers gladly help. In the buffet tent results can also be followed on the big screen TVs.

# **Competition doctor:**

Medical service is in the Event Centre (Roosevelt square).




# Relay start number description:

# Sketch of the Relay finish:




